## 2022-23 STUDENT HEALTH INSURANCE PLAN

### Who is eligible?

**All full-time, matriculated undergraduate, graduate, and law students** are automatically charged for the Student Health Insurance Plan. Students should proactively enroll through MySlice to obtain an ID card. Students have the opportunity to waive the Student Health Insurance Plan by providing proof of qualifying coverage through MySlice.

Fall deadline: Monday, Sept.19, 2022\*

Spring deadline: Tuesday, Feb. 7, 2023\*

Anticipated Annual Rate August 1, 2022 - July 31, 2023	\$2,347.00
Anticipated Fall Only Rate August 1, 2022 - December 31, 2022	\$1,010.00
Anticipated Spring Only Rate January 1, 2023 - July 31, 2023	\$1,382.00

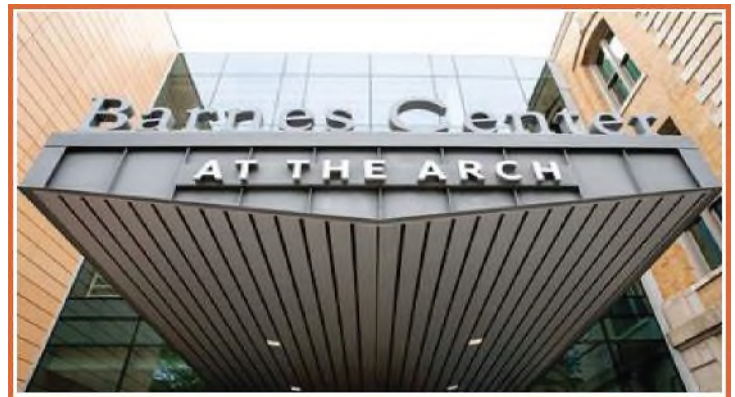

<b>Deductible- Individual</b>	\$100
<b>Out-of-Pocket Maximum- Individual</b>	\$4,000
<b>Office Visits- Primary Care &amp; Specialists</b>	\$25 copayment, then 0% coinsurance
<b>Preventive Care Services</b>	Covered in full
<b>Emergency Ambulance Transportation (not SUA)</b>	10% coinsurance after deductible
<b>Medical Emergency (Emergency Room)</b>	10% coinsurance, after deductible
<b>Urgent Care Services</b>	\$50 copayment after policy year deductible, then 10% coinsurance
<b>Inpatient Hospital Surgery</b>	(Pre-authorization required) 10% coinsurance after deductible
<b>Outpatient Surgery</b>	10% coinsurance, after deductible
<b>Mental Health Care Services- Inpatient</b>	(Pre-authorization required for non-emergency admissions) 10% coinsurance after deductible
<b>Mental Health Care Services- Outpatient</b>	\$25 copayment, then 0% coinsurance after deductible
<b>Laboratory Procedures- Performed in a PCP Office, Specialist Office, &amp; Performed as Outpatient Hospital Services</b>	10% coinsurance after deductible
<b>Allergy Testing and Treatment- Performed in PCP &amp; Specialist Office</b>	10% coinsurance after deductible
<b>Imaging Services</b>	(Pre-authorization required) 10% coinsurance after deductible
<b>Diabetic Equipment and Supplies(30 day supply)</b>	\$15 copayment then 0% coinsurance after deductible
<b>Telemedicine (Teladoc 24/7 on-demand access to doctors over-the-phone)</b>	Use cost-sharing for appropriate service (Primary Care Office Visit, Specialist Office Visit, Diagnostic Radiology Services, Laboratory Procedures and Diagnostic Testing)
<b>Prescription Drugs (30 day supply)</b>	Copayment: \$15 generic, \$30 brand name, & \$50 non-formulary brands

As a Syracuse University student enrolled in the Student Health Insurance Plan, you have access to Aetna's Teladoc services. Teladoc is a way to be treated for non-severe medical issues without having to physically visit a provider's office. Through Teladoc, you can be treated for all of the following:

- General Medical (24/7 care by web, phone or mobile app): Cold & flu, allergies, bronchitis, sinus infection, rash, sore throat, skin problems, and respiratory infections.
- Behavioral Health (video appointments available 7am-9pm seven days a week): Support for anxiety, eating disorders, depression, and family issues.
- Dermatology (log into your Teladoc account to upload images to get started): treatment for complex issues such as psoriasis, eczema, and acne.
